One Month To Live - Week 2

Going Deeper Small Group Discussion Questions

(from Chapters 3 - 8)

Read Luke 5:18-26

1. What consumes most of your time each day? How much of any given day do you spend doing only what you do best?
2. What activities in your life would you consider "wasted time"?
3. What area of your life are you struggling most to change? Spiritual, Physical, Emotional, Relational. Are you trying to change with willpower or with God's power?
4. What are some ways you have experience God's pruning in your life? How have you handled the pruning? What were the results of the pruning?
5. What are the current barriers to spiritual health in your life?
6. What are you clinging to right now that you need to let go in order to move forward in your life? What keeps you from trusting that God will catch you?
7. What areas of your life are you more likely to take a risk – personal, professional, relational or spiritual? Why do seem to find it easier to take a risk in some areas but not others?
8. When have you been disappointed with God? How did He not come through for you the way you wanted Him to? Did this affect your relationship? How can you exercise trust in him even when you feel the Father has disappointed you?
9. How do you distinguish between your own selfish dreams and the God-given dream planted in your life? Currently, how connected are you to your dreams?
10. How has God reinforced His dream for your life?
11. What's the hardest lesson you've learned from one of your life crashes? How has learning that lesson strengthened your character?
12. What's your greatest fear about trusting God completely with your life? Why do you think you have that fear?
